The Galaxy 3 is user friendly. You can easily move through the screens by using the "up" and "down" arrows and "red enter" button.

- 1. Green Fees are being used this year, so no quarters!
- 2. At "Main Menu" select tournament mode, day of play, and game, by using the "up" and "down" arrows.
- 3. Use the "down" arrow to advance to "Start Game". Push red button to start game.

IMPORTANT CHARTING RULES

We use the Tournament King Registration computerized system. There are 10 numbered mini stages with TV monitors on each stage. These TV monitors will be used to display charts with player assignments throughout the tournament.

At registration, you will be given a mini stage number and specific time to report to your stage. All players must report to their mini stage 10 minutes before shooting time. Each player will be responsible for keeping track of his/her position on the chart. NO MATCHES WILL BE ANNOUNCED. Find your name on the TV monitor. When a board number is positioned beside your match, proceed immediately to the board indicated and play your match.

After the match is over, <u>BOTH</u> winner and loser must report to their mini stage.

Watch the position you move to on the TV monitor and wait for your next board assignment.

BULLSHOOTER RULES

- 1. You MUST HAVE A QUALIFYING CARD to participate in the main events.
- 2. 20 grams is the maximum dart weight.
- 3. Only three practice darts per player.
- 4. You must report to your mini stage 10 minutes before the event and be in the tournament room when the event is being played.
- 5. You must report promptly to the board to play your match, as soon as it is posted.
- 6. Machine abuse will not be tolerated.
- 7. Must have your SS# and ID to receive prize money. If you want to cash your check, you must do so at the time you receive it. You can NOT cash it later.
- 8. Decisions on disputes made by tournament officials will be final.
- Proper conduct and behavior will be required of all players at all times. Any player displaying misconduct will be asked to leave the playing area and will be eliminated from the tournament competition.
- 10. Scoring: The "last dart" (winning dart) will end the game, even if the dart game does not record the score, as long as the dart is sticking in the board.
- 11. A "missed" dart (dart that sticks but does not register) may be backed up and manually scored only by an official.
- 12. There is a maximum of 30 seconds between players shooting the next round. A complete three dart turn may last only 90 seconds.
- 13. Dart manufacturers, their employees and reps are ineligible to participate.

STARTING YOUR MATCH

Quantity of games may vary depending on entries.

A. 2 of 3 Game Matches

Open Events - Start with coin flip.

- 1. Flip winner goes first in first game.
- 2. Loser of first game goes first in second.
- 3. Diddle to start third game, loser of game two has option.
- 4. A maximum of 30 seconds between players shooting next round. A complete three dart turn may last only 30 seconds. **Pro Events -** Start with diddle.
- 1. Flip a coin to determine who diddles first. Winner goes first in first game.
- 2. Loser of first game goes first in second.
- 3. Diddle to start third game, loser of game two has option.
- 4. A maximum of 30 seconds between players shooting next round. A complete three dart turn may last only 30 seconds.
- B. One Game Matches Start with diddle.
- 1. Flip a coin to determine who diddles first.
- 2. A maximum of 30 seconds between players shooting next round. A complete three dart turn may last only 30 seconds.

PRACTICE DARTS

Three warm-up darts are allowed before starting a match. Remember, only one turn--three darts only!

DOUBLE IN/DOUBLE OUT

In 501 DI/DO, the Bullseye may NOT be used as an IN or OUT dart. If a player shoots a Bull to start or end the game, they lose the game. (Pro AA '01 games use a split Bull and can double Bull Out.)

DIDDLE FOR THE MIDDLE

One player from each team throws one dart for the center of the Bullseye. The player whose dart comes closest to the exact center of the Bull throws first. If a player hits the exact center with the first dart, the player removes the dart and allows the next player to shoot for a tie. Don't pull darts if tie, re-diddle with second dart. The dart must stick on the diddle. If it does not, throw another dart until one sticks. Either team member may diddle.

TOE LINE

A player's foot can be on the toe line. No part of the shoe can go past the front edge of the line.

FIVE MAIN EVENTS

One Qualifying Card per player. Each player holding a Qualifying Card may enter a maximum of FIVE main events. Any player registered under a name other than his/her own, registered more than once in an event, or entered in more than five events, will forfeit any prize money that he/she wins and will be immediately eliminated from all tournament events.

REGISTRATION

Original, unaltered Qualifying Cards must be presented at registration. Partners in doubles events must register together, in person, and each must have a Qualifying Card.

WEIGHT LIMIT

20 grams maximum per dart. Violation of this rule will result in loss of game. Darts will be confiscated and returned only after elimination from all events.

ELIGIBILITY/ENTRY CLARIFICATION

BullShooter tournament management reserves the right to evaluate entries based on knowledge of past tournament accomplishments in the sport of darting. It is the desire of Arachnid and the A-Team to provide as equalized competition as possible for all entrants. All decisions by BullShooter tournament management are binding and final.

All coin-op dart board manufacturers and their employees are ineligible to participate in the BullShooter Finals.

MISREPRESENTATION

Any player not using his/her correct name, or gaining entry by falsifying his/her name in any manner, will be eliminated from the event. All prize money and trophies won will be forfeited. The player will be barred from the tournament room and from future events.

WINNING DART

The "last dart" (winning dart) will end the game, even if the dart game does not record the score, as long as the dart is sticking in the board. A "missed" dart (dart that sticks but does not register) may be backed up and manually scored only by an Arachnid official.

MACHINE ABUSE

Machine abuse will not be tolerated. If you cause the game to fall--penalty is loss of match.

COACHING

In any team event, coaching will be allowed by your playing partner only. Long delays between darts or player turns will not be tolerated. There will be no coaching allowed in single events.

SPORTSMANSHIP

Good sportsmanship will prevail during the entire tournament. Any player displaying misconduct will be asked to leave the playing area and will be eliminated from the tournament competition.

PLAYER INDICATOR ARROW

In all matches, it is the player's responsibility to make sure the player arrow is on the right player position before you throw. Any darts thrown and scoring on the competitor's number is to their benefit. Penalty is darts already thrown.

MATCHES

During the tournament, your name, your opponent's name, or team nickname, and a dart board will be posted on your monitor. Go immediately to the dart board and play your match. The winner of the match must come to the stage area and report the win. You do not win the match until you report it to your stage. Losers must report to their stage if it is their first loss.

CONFLICTS

If any member of your team is involved in an ongoing event, a player from your team must notify your assigned mini stage of the conflict. The player will be asked to play in both events at the same time to avoid conflicts. Any forfeit resulting from non-notification will stand!

FREEZE RULE

A player may go out and win, only if your partner's score is equal to or lower than the opposing team's combined score. Tie in points wins the game.

PRIZE PAYOUT

In order to receive any prize payout, you must have proper photo identification and social security number. If you want to cash a prize money check, you must do so at the time you receive it at payout. You can NOT cash it later.

RECALL PROCEDURE

Go to board when the board number is placed by your name. Wait five minutes, if the opponent(s) do not show, report back to your mini stage.

A Recall will be announced over the loud speaker. If your opponent(s) does not show within five minutes, return to mini stage. The match will be forfeited and announced over the loud speaker.

In Team Events, all players must be present and ready to play at the assigned board. If only one player is at the board, the team is not present.

TOURNAMENT FORMAT AND/OR GAME PLAYED

Arachnid reserves the right to make any changes to the tournament format or game to be played in any event as deemed necessary.

Players not willing to accept these changes may withdraw from the tournament. No refunds will be given after the event has started.
